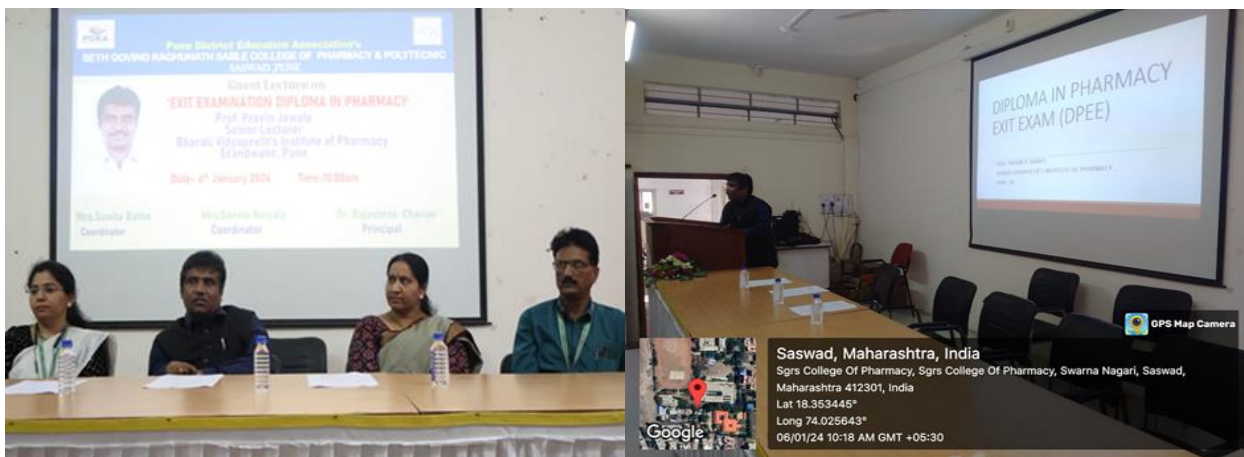

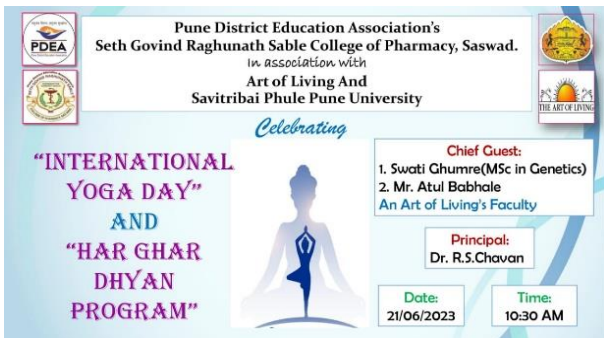
Reading day (19/06/2023) -

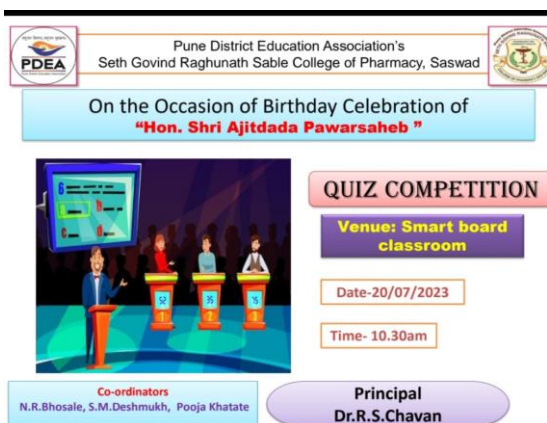
International Yoga Day (21/06/2023)

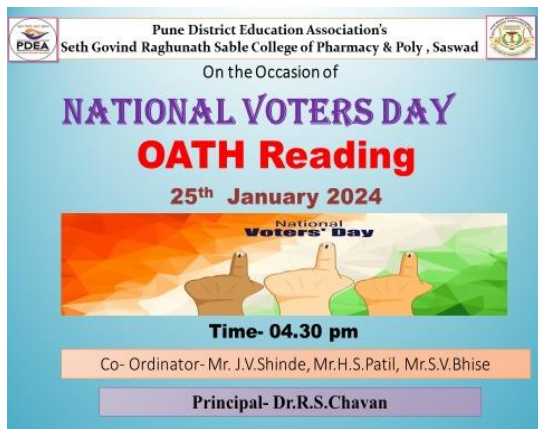


Disaster management programme(6/12/2023)

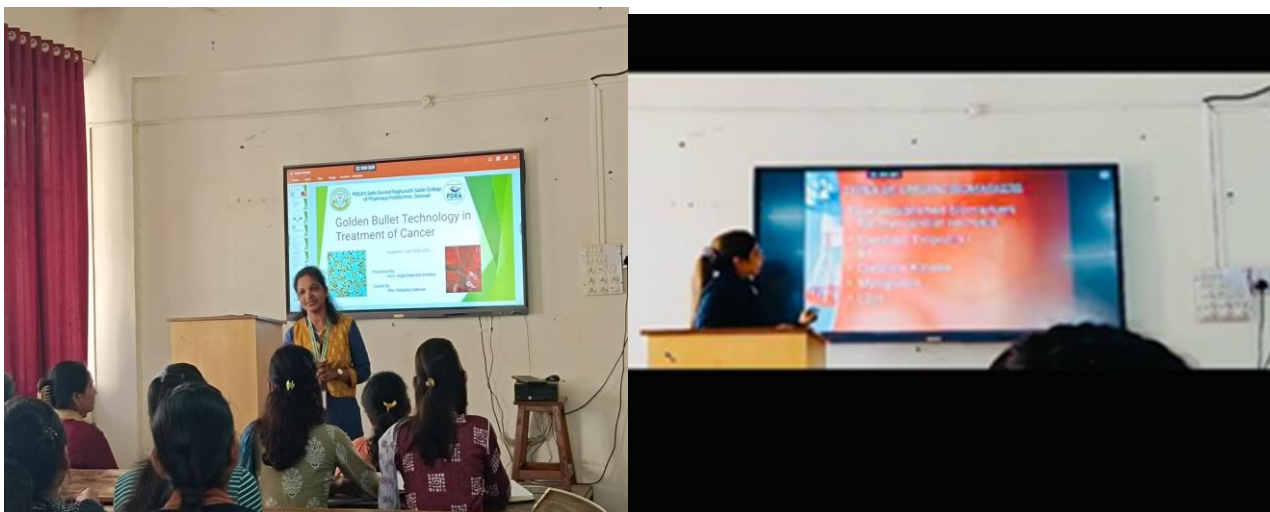
Science Exhibition and Idea Innovation Competition (22/02/2024)

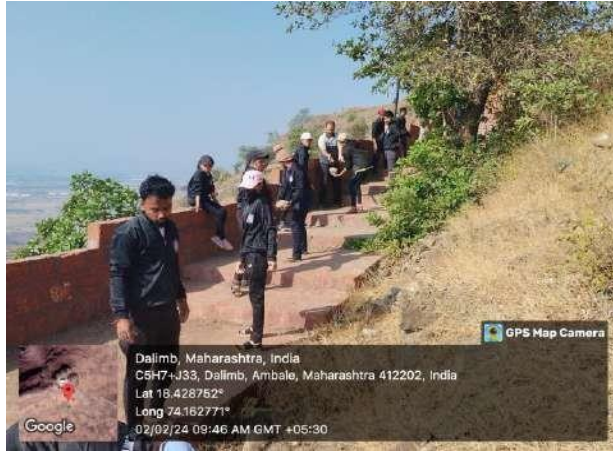

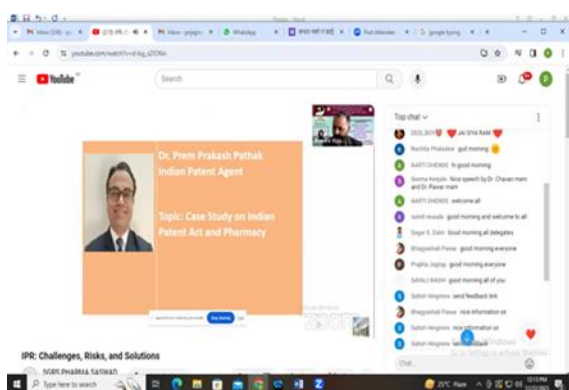
